Courses are held at the Pine Forest Art Centre in the Dublin mountains. The Art Centre is set in beautiful scenery surrounded by mountains, woods and streams. There are private bus services to and from the Centre from Dundrum, Stillorgan, Goatstown, Blackrock, Templeogue, Firhouse, Terenure, Foxrock, Rathfarnham, Knocklyon, Monkstown and Dunlaoghaire, stopping at intermediate points.

The fee includes the cost of all art and craft materials. Bus fare for each student is an additional €95 per student, per course. There is no sliding scale of fees for families. Students doing the portfolio course may contact the Centre to discuss individual programmes if they wish.

Bus Service

A private bus service is available. The fare per student, per course is €95. The bus will stop en route where it is safe to do so. Intermediate stops must be arranged beforehand with the bus driver and a Pine Forest Art Centre staff member. The main bus pick up points are:
